The Pastor's Message

Dear People of Jolliff United Methodist Church:

Greetings to you in the name of Jesus, our Lord and Savior.

As we enter the month of July, I give thanks to God for helping me complete the third year of ministry at Jolliff UMC. Looking back, I am amazed at how quickly the time has passed. At the same time, I humbly confess that everything has been by God's grace.



I also want to thank you for your faithful participation in our church ministries—through your prayers, your presence, your gifts, and your service. It is both an honor and a joy to announce that I have been reappointed to Jolliff UMC and that our ministry together will continue.

As I begin my fourth year of ministry at Jolliff UMC, I prayerfully imagine what the Lord desires our church to be in this community.


